A ductwork installer installs the systems that provide clean air and/or remove used air as part of a building's ventilation system.

Where your career starts within building services engineering will depend upon a number of things, for example what type of work you want to do and what qualification you achieve.

Craft and technician engineers generally start on an apprenticeship scheme. These schemes lead to an N/SVQ Level 3 or 4. Incorporated and chartered engineers usually study a full or part time foundation, bachelors or masters degrees at a university.
