Martin went on to write two political novels and has worked on documentaries for the BBC exploring the legacy of the KGB in today's Russia.

He also wrote 'The Lost Child of Philomena Lee' which was adapted into the film Philomena, directed by Stephen Frears, starring Dame Judi Dench and Steve Coogan, as Sixsmith.
